

The Alameda County Board of Supervisors has backed a free dental program for Emeryville students, approving the funding for two dental chairs at the Emeryville Center of Community Life (ECCL), located at 4727 San Pablo Avenue. The ECCL thanks Supervisor Keith Carson for shepherding the funding of those two chairs.

Dental services, as well as medical services, will be provided by [Lifelong Medical Care at the School Based Health Center \(SBHC\) at the ECCL](#) to Emery students and will be a vital pillar of community support in Emeryville.

The clinic is set to open on August 25, 2016. Services will be provided to Emery Unified School District students at no cost. Core funding for the operation of the SBHC is provided by Alameda County HCSA.

In addition, the ECCL will be holding their official ribbon Cutting ceremony on Thursday, September 1 at 10:00am. Tours of the ECCL and information on its many other community resources and services will debut at that time.
